One voice which can be difficult to discern at times, is the voice of our adversary, the devil. The Apostle Peter encourages the Christian to be sober and vigilant because your adversary the devil walks about as a roaring lion, seeking those whom he may devour...resist him steadfast in the faith. Most often the toughest battles are the battles of the mind, competing thoughts which wrestle one against another, speaking to us through our experiences, reasons, logic, emotions, and desires. Many times the devil masquerades as the voice of reason, coming to you through your thoughts. Learn to recognize the voice of the enemy and do not follow him.
