The army of God is not intended to preserve where God has been and what God has done, but rather to pursue where God wants to go and what God wants to do



Those called to His army must understand that we are to *engage and advance* this Gospel until the whole world has heard. We cannot become satisfied with what God has already done but must press ever forward to accomplish all He wants to do. The church, God's army, is not a refrigerator but rather an incubator.

Sinners are being born every day and generations pass from this earth having lived their chance to hear the Good News and make Jesus their Lord. It is not enough that one generation has heard ... every generation must hear. And we must therefore press on ever vigilant and ever determined to accomplish God's will while we yet have time.

Prayer for Today

Father, give me the grace and the stamina to work in Your fields as long as I have life. Help me to teach others the value of pressing on with the Great Commission until the whole world hears.
