The story of Balaam continues in the book of Numbers and shows Balaam getting deeper and deeper into sin. At first he only entertained the thought of sin. Left unchecked, unchallenged, and unchanged, sin will consume a person step by step. Mistakes or errors left to themselves will become ways of life, and ways of life are harder to challenge and change than simple, one-time mistakes.
