What do you think of a person whom the Creator of the universe, Who could have anything He wanted, paid the highest price imaginable hoping that



He might be able to obtain a relationship with that person?

The value of an object is often determined by what a person is willing to pay for that object. God so loved mankind that He gave His only Son on the cross of Calvary for the chance to begin a relationship with you. He purchased the opportunity He desired to make every person His child.

When we pass people on the street, in the marketplace, or in social settings, we should consider the value of each one as equal to the Son of God in our Father's eyes and we should further treat one another as God has treated us. For the sake of Christ Jesus we should treat every person regardless of race, gender, national origin, or economic status just like God treats us.
