One of the Old Testament names for God is Jehovah Jireh. Generally, this term is connected to God's name to usefully describe Him as a provider. However, its literal meaning is "in the mount of the Lord it shall be seen". Our father of faith first described God as the One who would make provision available in the place of His choosing. In Abraham's case, God instructed him to journey to a certain mountain where Abraham found provision waiting on his arrival. These things were not recorded in the Bible just to inform us of Abraham's journey, but rather to encourage us on our journey as well. You, like Abraham, will find provision made available and waiting for you at every critical moment and all along your journey with God. God does not point where He will not also provide. Trust in the Lord for He is Jehovah Jireh.

Prayer for Today

Show me Your way, oh Lord, and give me understanding as to the path You desire for me to travel. Take me to my appointed route, making provision along the way. I put my trust in You as my source.

Scriptures for Today

Genesis 22:14 And Abraham called the name of the place, The-LORD-Will Provide; as it is said to this day, "In the Mount of the LORD it shall be provided." (NKJV)

Romans 4:1 What then shall we say that Abraham our father has found according to the flesh? (NKJV)

Romans 4:20-24 He did not waver at the promise of God through unbelief, but was strengthened in faith, giving glory to God, and being fully convinced that what He had promised He was also able to perform.
